Composite	A cone-shaped volcano made of

Shield	A broad volcano with gently
	sloping sides.
Hazard	A hazard is a potential threat to
	human life and property caused by
	an event.
Management	The ways that people cope with the
	effects of natural hazards such as
	earthquakes and volcanoes.
