New Deal (First and Second)	A series of programmes and policies designed to fix the Great Depression- Introduced by Roosevelt.
Propaganda	Often misleading information designed to promote a particular message or cause.
War Bonds	Sold by the government to raise money during the war with the promise of being paid back.
Internment Camp	Camps where Japanese Americans were held during World War 2.
