Reformation	A period of major religious change and conflict across Europe in the 1500s that led to a split in the Church
Rebellion	An open effort made people to fight for change against their government using protest and violence
Protest	When people make statements or actions to express their objection to something
Empire	The collective name for a group of countries that are ruled by a single person, government or country
Parliament	A group of elected people that make decisions and laws for a country
Puritanism	A religious movement that aimed to remove any links to the Catholic Church
Civil War	A conflict between two sides from the same country

Famine	An extreme shortage of food in one
