Polymer	Large molecule that plastics are made from
Fractional Distillation	Separates crude oil into useful hydrocarbons
	called monomers - the monomers are joined to
	create a polymer
Epoxy Resin	A type of adhesive
HIPS	High Impact Polystyrene, a plastic used for
	vacuum forming
Thermoforming	A type of plastic that can be heated and
	reformed multiple times
Thermosetting	A type of plastic that once formed is set and can
	not be reformed again
Stabilisers	These can be added to make plastic more
	resistant to heat and light
Plasticisers	These can be added to make plastic more flexible
Acrylic	A transparent plastic that is very strong but
	brittle
