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| Keyword  | <b>Definition</b>  |
| Hand   | A decorative stitching technique on fabric with  |
| Embroidery   | needle and thread  |
| Production Plan  | The plan for how to manufacture a product  |
| Bobbin   | A small wheel that holds the thread in the sewing machine  |
| Pattern Symbols  | Symbols that are on a garment pattern to achieve accurate results when cutting and matching pieces |
| Friction Pen   | A pen that will erase with heat  |
| Stabiliser   | Supports the fabric and maintains the structure when embroidering                                  |
| Satin Stitch   | Satin stitch covers an area completely by filling side by side                                     |
| Couching Stitch  | Laying a piece of embroidery thread down and sewing over it to create a raised stitch              |
| Split Stitch   | A chain type stitch formed by bringing the needle through the middle of the previous stitch        |
| Components   | Any extra item that you add to a product that isn't fabric e.g. buttons, sequins                   |
