|-------------------------------|--|
| Primary Sector | Extracting raw materials from the land, sea or air eg. farming, mining, fishing, forestry |
| Secondary Sector | Turning primary materials into finished products eg. car building, food processing, construction |
| Tertiary Sector | Providing services to individuals and other businesses eg. teaching, banking, retail, nursing |
| Quaternary Sector | Generation and sharing of hi-tech knowledge eg. medical research, web page design |
| Manufacturing | The process of making a product |
| Industrialisation | The rapid development of industry brought about by the introduction of machinery |
| Deindustrialisation | The decline in manufacturing (secondary) industry |
| UK traditional economy | Coal mining, engineering, manufacturing |
| Globalisation | The integration of economic, financial, social and cultural ideas and contacts between countries |
