<b>Keyword</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>Abolitionists</b>	<b>People that campaigned against enslavement and the trade in enslaved Africans</b>
<b>Assimilation</b>	<b>The process of absorption of people from different countries and different cultures,</b>
<b>Denization</b>	<b>The right to live in England as a citizen, granted by the monarch</b>
<b>Naturalisation</b>	<b>The right to live in England as a citizen, granted by Parliament</b>
<b>Emancipation</b>	<b>Freedom achieved by people (e.g. from enslavement)</b>
<b>Asylum seekers</b>	<b>Someone that has applied to be accepted as a refugee</b>
<b>Refugee</b>	<b>Someone that has escaped danger in their own country</b>
<b>Deportation</b>	<b>When people are removed from the country by force and against their will.</b>
<b>Famine</b>	<b>Extreme lack of food in a region, leading to starvation</b>
<b>Missionary</b>	<b>A religious person who goes to a place to help people and spread their religion</b>
