Keyword	Definition
Nucleus	The nucleus controls what happens inside the cell. Chromosomes are structures found in the nucleus of most cells. The plural of nucleus is nuclei.
DNA	Deoxyribonucleic acid. The material inside the nucleus of cells, carrying the genetic information of a living being.
Uterus	Where a fertilised egg develops into an embryo and then a foetus.
Ovary	A female sex gland where cells are made.
Cervix	Lower part of the uterus that opens into the vagina.
Penis	Organ that releases sperm and urine.
Sperm Duct	Tubes that sperm travels through on the way out of the penis.
Testes	Produce sperm and make sex hormones.
