Equality

Equality:

Students are learning about how the concept of Equality emerges from religious and secular perspectives. They will analyse this from a historical, theological and legal perspective.

Keyword	Definition
Hypostatic Union	That Jesus is fully human and fully God in one “person”. This means every human being has infinite value. This is where the expression to treat someone like a “person” comes from.
Imago Dei	That all human beings are made in the image and likeness of God.
Human Rights	The secular argument that certain things should be protected for all human beings simply being human e.g. the right to life or to freedom.
Secular	An argument or perspective that does not include God within its worldview.
Discrimination	To treat some people differently and negatively compared to others
Racism	To treat people badly because of their race
Sexism	Treating either men or women differently and negatively simply because of their sex.
Inequality	When people are treated in an unequal way
Social Justice	Working for a fairer world
Prejudice	Making a judgment about someone without getting to know them (literally pre-judging)
Stereotype	Generalised views about other people that can be unfair or simply wrong.
