Topic Title: The Foundations of Rome

Students will begin their study of Ancient Rome, considering the relationship between myth and reality in the exploration of the 7 kings of Rome

Keyword	Definition
Aeneas	Mythical figure from the Trojan War, said to have founded the city of Alba Longa which has strong connections with early Rome.
Etruscan	A region of Italy where early populations developed strong cultural practices, many of which are found in early Rome.
Romulus & Remus	Twins from Alba Longa who founded the city of Rome. Romulus was the first king of Rome from 753-716 BC.
Numa Pompilius	The second king of Rome from 715-627 BC
Tullus Hostilius	Third king of Rome from 672-640 BC
Ancus Marcius	Fourth king of Rome from 640-616 BC
Lucius Tarquinius Priscus	Fifth king of Rome and first king of Etruscan descent, from 616-578 BC
Servius Tullius	Sixth king of Rome and second king of Etruscan descent, from 578-534 BC
Lucius Tarquinius Superbus	Last king of Rome from 534-509 BC
Republic	The system of government established after the monarchy was overthrown.
