Keyword	Definition
Calamity	An event causing great and often sudden damage or distress; a disaster.

Desperation	Feeling hopeless and leading to rash decisions
Plague	A disease that spreads around the population and causes a large number of people to die
Black Death	A specific example of a plague that spread in 14 <sup>th</sup> century Europe
Rebellion/revolt	An uprising of people who want to overthrow their leaders
Widespread	Something that effects a wide variety of people
Feudal system	The system by which society ran, established by the Normans. This decided who was in control of land, food production and the military.
Accountability	Taking responsibility for something
