<b>Keyword</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>Empire</b>	<b>A large group of countries ruled by a single country or monarch</b>
<b>Monarch</b>	<b>The king or queen</b>
<b>Motherland</b>	<b>The leading country of an Empire</b>
<b>Colony</b>	<b>A country, state or territory ruled over by another country, state or territory.</b>
<b>Colonisation</b>	<b>The process of turning a country, state or territory into a colony</b>
<b>Migration</b>	<b>Moving to a new country</b>
<b>Settlers</b>	<b>People who migrated to a new country</b>
<b>Indigenous people</b>	<b>The people who originate in a particular area, rather than those who migrated there.</b>
<b>Missionaries</b>	<b>People who travel to spread their religion to new people.</b>
<b>Rebellion/revolt</b>	<b>An uprising of people who want to overthrow their leaders</b>
