










Icon	Word	Definition/In a Sentence
	analyse	<b>Analyse</b> means to examine something methodically and in detail, typically in order to explain and interpret it.
	chronology	<b>Chronology</b> means the order of events, or retelling events in the order in which they happened.
	conjunction	A <b>conjunction</b> is a word used to connect, link or contrast clauses or sentences.
	connotation	A <b>connotation</b> is an idea or meaning associated with a word in addition to its literal meaning.
	explicit	<b>Explicit</b> information is information that you are told directly.
	eyewitness	A <b>eyewitness</b> is a person who has seen something happen first-hand.
	implicit	<b>Implicit</b> information is information that you have to work out (infer) from clues.
	Imply	<b>Imply</b> means to suggest.
	Infer	<b>Infer</b> means to work something out based on hints or clues.
	likewise	<b>Likewise</b> means in the same way.
	linguistic	<b>Linguistic</b> means to do with language or words.
	phenomenon	A <b>phenomenon</b> is something for which there is no scientific proof; an amazing event that cannot always be explained by logic or science.
	portrayal	A <b>portrayal</b> is a depiction or description of something or someone.
	reliable	<b>Reliable</b> means trustworthy and believable.
	whereas	<b>Whereas</b> means in contrast with or different from.
