	chorus	The chorus is a group of supporting performers in a production.
	colloquial	Colloquial means informal or non-standard language, often used in casual conversation.
	cyclical	Cyclical structure is when a narrative starts and finishes with the same scene.
	destiny	Destiny means fate, or the idea that a person's future is already decided.
	dramatic irony	Dramatic irony is when the audience know something that the characters do not.
	fraternal	Fraternal means brothers, or like brothers; brotherly.
	maternal	Maternal means to do with being a mother, or refers to a mother-like relationship; motherly.
	motif	A motif is a recurring idea or symbol in a literary text.
	nature	Your nature is the qualities or characteristics that you are born with; including your personality traits.
	nurture	Nurture means to care for something as it grows.
	overture	An overture is a musical piece at the opening of a play, musical, or opera.
	prologue	A prologue is a separate introductory section of a literary, dramatic, or musical work.
	superstitious	Superstitious means believing in the supernatural; believing in things for which there is no scientific proof.
