Standard of living	The amount of money (or wealth) a

Gross National Income (GNI)	A measurement of standard of living: the
	value of the total amount of goods and
	services a country produces – in effect
	the amount of money a country has
Gross National Income (GNI) per	Another measurement of standard of
capita	living: the amount of money an individual
•	has – in effect their individual wealth
Quality of life	A person's access to services such as
	housing, education and healthcare
High Income Country	A country with a high total GNi and high
	average GNi per capita (over \$13,845)
Low Income Country	A country with a low total GNi and low
	average GNi per capita (less than \$1045)
Newly Emerging Economy	A country that has experienced rapid
	economic growth and increase in GNI,
	usually through industrial development
Human Development Index (HDI)	A measure of development using life
	expectancy, average years of schooling
	and GNI per capita (based on an
	individual's purchasing power)
Trade	The buying and selling of goods and
	services between countries
Exports	Goods that are sold out of a country to
	another country
Imports	Goods that are bought into a country from
	another country
Aid	The giving of assistance from a country or
	organisation to a different country, either
	in response to a natural disaster or to
	help the country to develop
