Keyword	Definition
Armaments/Munitions	Military weapons and equipment.
Artillery	Large guns used in warfare e.g. cannons
Cavalry	A mounted soldier, usually on horseback.
Chemical Warfare	Using toxic substances as a weapon of war.
Infantry	A foot soldier.
Legion	A Roman unit of 5000 fighters.
Militarism	The belief that a country should have a strong army and use it to expand.
Stalemate	A situation where no one is winning or losing.
Total War	A war where all of a nation's resources are devoted to fighting it.
Trench Warfare	A type of land warfare where soldiers fight between two positions that are dug into the ground.
